Peroxisomal disorder patients are often dealing with eleven to twelve symptoms at one time

Peroxisomal disorder patients, on average, are administered thirteen to fourteen treatments at one time to manage symptoms



Hypotonia, vision loss, hearing loss and intellectual disability are the most frequently reported symptoms in peroxisomal disorders



Vision loss is often ranked as the most impactful symptom in peroxisomal disorders



Other symptoms that rate high in impact include mobility and intellectual disability

The highest ranked (and rated) impact in peroxisomal disorders is their effect on independent activities of daily living
